

BOUNCE SERVICE CONSENT

In accordance with the Victorian Health Records Act 2001 and the Federal Privacy Act 1998

Dear Squad Member,

Waverley Gymnastics Centre respects your right to privacy.

Waverley Gymnastics Centre also has a duty to take reasonable measures to safeguard your health and safety as a gymnast.

If you have an existing injury or illness, or may in the future sustain any injury or illness that may affect your gymnastics training ("**Illness or Injury**"), it is important for you to immediately notify your coach of this so that we may be able to assist you with your rehabilitation and to avoid any aggravation of your Injury or Illness.

We also request that you provide to your coach necessary medical information about any Illness or Injury as soon as you become aware of it, in order to enable us to determine how it should be best managed.

Waverley Gymnastics Centre offers its gymnasts the opportunity to use the services of the qualified staff conveniently located on site at the Mt Waverley campus at the gymnasts' own cost. These services include physiotherapy and myotherapy. Our squad gymnasts are proudly supported by Bounce Health Group who are Australian leaders in Sports Science and Sports Medicine. Bounce provides Physiotherapy sessions (Tuesdays and Fridays) each week and Myotherapy (Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays) weekly. Bounce also provide 6 days a week treatment at their Blackburn, Ringwood and Rowville treatment centres.

Bounce provide the very latest information, results and follow up, and communicate this directly to relevant parents, gymnasts, coaches and High Performance personnel to ensure we are all working together to provide the very best support for every gymnast in our program. Because of their unique expertise and experience in gymnastics specific injury management and treatment, we strongly recommend all our gymnasts use these services so we can ensure the very best management for each of our gymnasts.

In utilising the services of Bounce Health Group, you authorise the staff at Bounce Health Group to communicate directly with the relevant coaching and High Performance personnel at Waverley Gymnastics Centre and vice versa about any Illness or Injury that I have, or may have in future, and for the disclosure by the staff at Bounce Health Group to the relevant coaching and High Performance personnel at Waverley Gymnastics Centre of such Illness or Injury (including test results and screenings) ("**Bounce Service Consent**").

This Bounce Service Consent will assist Waverley Gymnastics Centre's coaches and High Performance staff to:

- provide you with effective and efficient assistance with any rehabilitation that may be necessary while you are being coached as a gymnast at the Waverley Gymnastics Centre;
- consistently manage any rehabilitation that may be necessary; and
- avoid any aggravation of any Injury or Illness that you may have, or may sustain in future ("**Assistance**").

In giving Bounce Service Consent:

1. any information that we receive about any Illness or Injury that you may have:
 - a. will, subject to the matters below, be kept by Waverley Gymnastics Centre and will be maintained in the strictest of confidence;
 - b. will not be disclosed to any third parties outside of Waverley Gymnastics Centre unless required by law or, if we deem it necessary, to disclose relevant information about your Illness or Injury, in the following circumstances:
 - i. if you participate as a gymnast in National Championships - to any medical practitioners engaged by the body and/or persons who are responsible for holding the National Championships, because of health and safety reasons;
 - ii. if you participate as a gymnast in State Championships or State Trials – to Gymnastics Victoria, because of health and safety reasons;
 - iii. If you are a National Squad Member – to the relevant representative at these organisations, in accordance with our obligations towards them under any relevant agreement;
 - iv. if, because of your Illness or Injury we need to apply for special consideration or an event refund from bodies such as Gymnastics Victoria, Gymnastics Australia or other gymnastics event organisers and it becomes necessary to provide such organisations and/or organisers with relevant information of your Illness or Injury for that purpose;
 - c. will not be used for any other purpose other than for the purpose of providing the Assistance to you, or for the purposes referred to in paragraph 1(b) above;
2. if we disclose any information that we receive about any Illness or Injury in the circumstances described in paragraph 1(b) above, we will notify you of the details of the disclosure as soon as reasonably practicable after we do so;
3. you may withdraw this Bounce Service Consent at any time by providing us with written notification to this effect;
4. you are entitled to request access to all information that is provided to us about you relating to your Illness or Injury and to request us to correct any information that is inaccurate, incomplete, misleading or not up to date.

PAYMENT OF ACCOUNT

I acknowledge that it is my responsibility to ensure any outstanding account for services received from the staff at Bounce Health Group is paid in a timely fashion. Services include but are not limited to myotherapy, physiotherapy, specialist consultations and Injury Prevention classes as per the requirements of your squad. Failure to pay your account will result in the withholding of any further services until this account is paid. Please note also as per the WGC Squad Fee Policy, to represent the club at any competition(s)/camp(s), tuition fees as well as accounts issued by Bounce Health Group for services provided as a Waverley Gymnast must be paid completely up to date.
