

PROTOCOLS FOR PRIMARY CLOSE CONTACTS (PCC) AND POSITIVE COVID-19 MEMBERS

WAVERLEY GYMNASTICS CENTRE

Scenario 1

You are notified your child is a Primary Close Contact (PCC) as a result of encountering a positive COVID-19 case outside of Waverley Gymnastics Centre (WGC).

- Notify the relevant Program Coordinator immediately and keep your child home. If at WGC, your child will need to be collected as soon as practicable.
- Isolate as directed by the Department of Health.
- Obtain a negative COVID-19 test on the applicable day of the isolation period.
- Email the negative COVID-19 test result or clearance provided from the Department of Health to your Program Coordinator prior to your child returning to WGC.

Scenario 2

Your child returns a positive COVID-19 test.

- Notify the relevant Program Coordinator immediately and keep your child home.
- Isolate as directed by the Department of Health.
- Obtain a negative COVID-19 test on the applicable day of the isolation period.
- Email the negative COVID-19 test result or clearance provided from the Department of Health to your Program Coordinator prior to your child returning to WGC.

Scenario 3

Your child is identified as a Primary Close Contact (PCC) as a result of encountering a positive COVID-19 case (staff or gymnast) at WGC.

- WGC will notify parents that their child has been identified as a PCC.
- WGC will send a list of all identified PCCs of the confirmed COVID-19 case to the Department of Health.
- If on-campus when identified as a PCC, your child will need to be collected as soon as practicable.
- You will be asked to have your child tested as soon as is practicable.
- You will be contacted by the Department of Health (this may take a few days).
- The Department of Health will advise you of your quarantine requirements, testing, and release dates.
- Isolate as directed by the Department of Health.
- Obtain a negative COVID-19 test on the applicable day of the isolation period.
- Email the negative COVID-19 test result or clearance provided from the Department of Health to your Program Coordinator prior to your child returning to WGC.

Points to note:

WGC will closely follow Department of Health advice in terms of all 'Deep Clean' requirements and potential closure of the facility for 24-48 hrs. Notification of closure will be sent via SMS and then by a follow-up email to all families

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
