2026 DATES

Gymnastics classes run from Monday 19th January until Sunday 20th December 2026, except for public holidays.

See below for the four key highlights of our world class Educational program. Please note that all of these events (with the exception of our optional GFA competition) occur during your child's regular class time.



TERM 1 - CORESKILLS TESTING:

Testing weeks: 10th - 21st March
Presentation week: 23rd - 28th March

Our Coreskills Testing occurs during class over a 2-week testing period, and incorporates eight key gymnastic skills (including handsprings, backflips and front saults), with each skill broken down into 9 progressions. The first progressions will be taught in the early years of gymnastics, starting with a very basic drill. The final progressions will be taught in the later years of gymnastics when they are able to successfully complete the advanced skill safely and correctly. A progress report and a congratulatory certificate are then awarded at the end of the assessment period.

TERMS 2 & 4 - GYMSKILLS LEVEL TESTING

Term 2:

- Testing weeks: 25th May - 6th June
- Presentation week: 15th - 20th June

Term 4:

- Testing weeks: 2nd - 14th November
- Presentation week: 23rd - 28th November

Children will be evaluated during class twice a year over a 2 week period, on the skills in our world-class GYMSKILLS curriculum. Our program creates a progressive pathway to help children optimise their learning. We aim for each child to pass 1-2 GYMSKILLS levels per year. Parents will receive a report on their child's progress as well as an amazing level pin for gymnasts of each level they have passed.



TERM 3 - GYMNASTICS FOR ALL COMPETITION: AUGUST 22ND, 23RD, 29TH & 30TH

All children are invited to compete in this optional event, held at our Oakleigh campus, which provides children an opportunity to experience a gymnastics competition in a relaxed, fun and rewarding environment. Children will learn the skills and routines within their normal classes, ready to perform at the actual competition. Every child at this event receives an award and the thrill of performing in front of an audience!

TERM 4 - END-OF-YEAR DISPLAY WEEK: 7th to 12th December

Parents and friends are invited to attend the End-of-Year Display held at our Oakleigh campus during each gymnast's regular class time, which is a chance to show family and friends what they have been learning throughout the year. All participants receive a trophy and a memento to celebrate the end of a fantastic year of learning.
